The judge hears all the witnesses and any other evidence presented by the prosecution and the defense. The judge decides whether the accused person is guilty or innocent on the basis of the evidence. If the accused is convicted then the judge pronounces the sentence. He may send the person to jail or impose a fine or both depending on what the law prescribes.
- 8 Any By the early eighteenth century worried by the popularity of Indian knitted wool and silk makers in England began protesting against the import of Indian cotton knitties. In 1720 the British Government enacted a legislation banning the use of knitted cotton knitties in England and interestingly this act was known as the Calico Act.
